There is aggressive opposition and conflict but Nehemiah also finds a bunch of like-minded people willing to be encouraged, inspired and involved. If you are looking for 'out-there' baby names, chapter 3 is a great source as it lists all the people each rebuilding and connecting the different bits of Jerusalem's walls and gates until it is restored.

9am - 12 Noon.**


If you are able to spare a few hours to help out with remedial repairs and maintenance in the halls and church, we'd really appreciate your help.

Our next Well-Being service is at **10:30am on Sunday 22nd February.**






