Last Sunday (18th Jan), in church, we read the excellent passage from near the end of John chapter 1 where John the Baptist points his followers towards Jesus and they go to find out what John has been talking about. When they ask Jesus, "Where are you staying?" he invites them to join him with the words – "Come and see!"

Thank you again.




Although it's a long way off, here is a date for your diary: Our next APCM will be on **Sunday 26th April** after our morning service.
